TF HTAP Continued Activities

- (i) Continue to plan, conduct and analyze multi-model experiments to evaluate intercontinental transport;**
- (ii) Provide input to the development of an improved emissions inventory for assessing intercontinental transport (EDGAR-HTAP) by incorporating emission estimates developed at the national and regional level;**
- (iii) Provide input to the development of reference databases of observational information from surface networks, aircraft campaigns, and satellites;**
- (iv) Support the development of an electronic information network to facilitate the integration and interoperability of relevant data on emissions, observations, and modelling information for the assessment of intercontinental transport;**

Meetings and Deliverables

- (a) Organise a workshop in early November 2009 (Toronto) for the drafting of the HTAP 2010 reports**
- (b) Organise a workshop in early March 2010 for the final drafting of the HTAP 2010 reports;**
- (c) Organize its annual meeting in the period end of May/early June 2010, focused on the draft HTAP 2010 Assessment reports;**
- (d) Deliver the HTAP 2010 Assessment reports PM and Ozone; POPs and mercury as well as the HTAP 2010 Synthesis report.**

Other Aspects

- (e) Continue the cooperation with the EMEP centres and individual Convention task forces, including the Task Force on Measurement and Modelling and the Task Force on Emission Inventories and Projections;**
- (f) Continue outreach efforts directed at experts in countries outside the UNECE region and international organisations dealing with global air pollution.**
